Care and Maintenance of Your New CDL Reel

- To clean the reel use a clean cloth or tooth brush in warm, soapy water to remove any dirt, grit or hard to clean surfaces.
- Rinse with cool fresh water.
- Separate spool from frame and dry all reel surfaces thoroughly.
- Store reel in pouch away from extreme heat.

As periodic maintenance or after use in saltwater, pay special attention to cleaning the reel:

- Perform the steps described above for cleaning the reel.
- After the reel surfaces have dried, apply a thin layer of lithium-type grease to bearing and shaft surfaces.
- Apply a small amount of light machine oil to one-way bearing located in the spool. Wipe off any excess oil as over-lubrication can be detrimental to the performance of this reel and is not recommended.
- Store reel in pouch away from extreme heat.

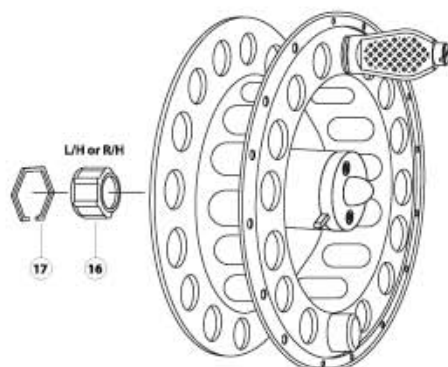
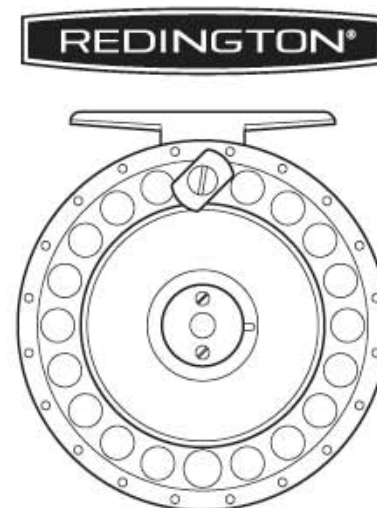

Retrieve Conversion

1. Remove the spool from the frame
2. Remove the one-way retainer clip (part 17)
3. Remove and invert one-way bearing (part 16)
4. Replace the one-way retainer clip (part 17)
5. Replace the spool to the frame
