


METAL CHAIR CO1001A



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Care: Use a soft clean cloth that will not scratch the surface when dusting. Use of furniture polish is not necessary. Should you choose to use polishes, test in an inconspicuous area first. Use of solvents of any kind may damage your furniture's finish. To clean, simply use a soft clean cloth moistened with lukewarm water, then buff with a dry soft clean cloth.

Step 1: Place the chair seat (B) on a solid flat surface. Position the chair back (A) as shown in (Figure 1) so that the holes in the chair back align with the holes in the chair seat. Insert Short Allen Bolt (1) through the holes of the chair back (A) and then through the holes in the chair seat. Add a 1/4" nut (4) to the end of each bolt. Tighten using hex wrench (7) and Allen Key driver (8). Do not over tighten. Cover nuts and bolts with covers (5 & 6). Repeat for remaining three holes on each back(A).



Step 2:Protective caps were used on the ends of Legs (C & D) for shipping. These will need to be removed for assembly and can be discarded.




Step 3:The holes in the chair seat/chair back assembly must be perfectly aligned with the holes in the chair leg assembly. While one person holds the chair seat/chair back assembly as shown in (*Figure 3*), have another person attach to the chair leg assembly. Add a E 6.5 x 1.0mm washer (3) to Long Allen Bolt (2) and insert through aligned holes in the rear arm and chair back.



Step 4:Insert the end of Leg Connector (E) into Legs (C & D). Attach Leg (D) to Chair Back (A) using Long Allen Bolt (2), Washer (3), 1/4" Nut (4) & Nut Cover (6) as shown. Note - The chair is designed for the Leg Connector (E) to be held in place with tension. You will need to turn the chair on it's side and press Leg (D) down to meet Chair Seat (B). Turn the chair on it's side with Leg (C) on a flat non-abrasive surface. Press Leg (D) down to meet Chair Seat (B) and attach using the same method as in Step #3. Turn the chair upright on it's base & it is ready for use.

If the chair is not square or sitting properly, slightly loosen the bolts, square up the chair, and re-tighten.



Step 1: Place the chair seat (B) on a solid flat surface. Position the chair back (A) as shown in (Figure 1) so that the holes in the chair back align with the holes in the chair seat. Insert 1/4"x15mm bolts (1) through the holes of the chair back (A) and then through the holes in the chair seat. Add a 1/4" nut (7) to the end of each bolt. Tighten using hex wrench (12) and Allen Key (13). Do not over tighten. Cover nuts and bolts with covers (8 & 9).Repeat for remaining three holes on each back(A).




Step 2: Join the two backs (A) by attaching them to the Upper Back Crossbar (D) using two Ø6.5 x 1.0 washers (6), two Ø6.5 x 6.0mm plastic washers (10), one 1/4"x 32mm bolt (3) and one 1/4"nut (7) as shown in (*Figure 2*). Tighten with hex wrench (12) and Allen Key (13). Do not over tighten. Cover nuts and bolts with covers (8 & 9).

Step 3: Join the two seats (B) by attaching them using two Ø 6.5 x 1.0 washers (6), one Ø 6.5 x 11.0mm plastic washers (11), one 1/4"x 25mm bolt (2) and one 1/4"nut (7) as shown in (*Figure 3*). Tighten with hex wrench (12) and Allen Key (13). Do not over tighten. Cover nuts and bolts with covers (8 & 9).




Step 4: Attach arm (C) to seat (B) and back (A) using 1/4"x42mm bolts (5), two Ø 6.5 x 1.0 washers (6), and 1/4" nuts (7) as shown in (Figure 4). Tighten with hex wrench (12) and Allen Key (13). Do not over tighten. Repeat for remaining Loveseat arm. Cover nuts and bolts with covers (8 & 9).



Step 5: Attach Upper Back Crossbar(D) and Lower Back Crossbar (E) to Arm rest (c) using 1/4"x40mm bolts (4), two Ø 6.5 x 1.0 washers (6) as (*Figure 5*). Tighten with Allen Key (13). Do not over tighten. Repeat for remaining Loveseat arm. Cover nuts and bolts with covers (8 & 9).

Step 6: Attach Front Crossbar(F) to Arm rest (C) using one 1/4"x42mm bolts (5), two Ø 6.5 x 1.0 washers (6) and one 1/4" nut (7) as (*Figure 6*). Tighten with hex wrench (12) and Allen Key (13). Do not over tighten. Repeat for remaining Loveseat arm. Cover nuts and bolts with covers (8 & 9).



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




Tools needed: Allen key(part#6) and Hex Wrench(part#7) (Included) Phillips Head Screw Driver(Not included)

Step1: Place tabletop upside down on a flat, non-abrasive surface. Attach table leg to tabletop using 1/4"x 15mm bolt (1) and 1/4" (2) washer as shown in (*Figure 1*). Add 1/4" nut (4) to the end of bolt. Tighten a few revolutions only. Do not tighten completely at this time as some adjustments may be necessary to the alignment of the table legs. Repeat for remaining two legs.




Step2: Insert table leg connector (C) in the center of the three legs as shown in Figure 2. Secure by inserting two ST4.2 x 33mm bolt (5) through the two holes in the center of the leg and into the leg connector as shown in (Figure 3). Tighten a few revolutions only. Do not tighten completely. Repeat for remaining two legs.



Step3: Make any adjustments to the parts to ensure they are properly aligned. At this time tighten all nuts and bolts using Allen Wrench (6) and hex wrench (7). Tighten each bolt connection a few revolutions at a time, rotating between bolt connections until all nuts and bolts are completely tightened. DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN. Cover bolts with PVC bolt covers. Turn table into the upright position.


STEP 1

Insert Square Nuts (Part #3) into position in both of the Leg Couplers (C).


Note - Be sure that the square nuts are completely inserted to the bottom of leg coupler.




STEP 2 - Attach the Leg Coupler (C) to two of the Legs (B) using Allen Bolts (Part #1) & Flat Washers (Part #2) as shown.




STEP 3 - Lay the Top (A) on a flat surface with the bottom lip facing up. Fit the flat ends of the legs under the lip of Top (A) aligning the hole of the Leg Coupler (C) with the hole in Top (A).




STEP 4 - Add a third Leg (B) fitting the flat end under the lip of Top (A) and attach using an Allen Bolt (Part #1) and Flat Washer (Part #2) as shown.




STEP 5 - Attach the second Leg Coupler (C) to the three Legs (B) using Allen Bolts (Part #1) & Flat Washers (Part #2) as shown.



STEP 6 - Add the fourth Leg (B) by fitting the flat end of the leg under the lip of the table and positioning the portion with the bolt holes into the Leg Coupler (C).




STEP 7 - Attach the fourth Leg (B) to the Leg Coupler (C) using Allen Bolts (Part #1) and Flat Washers (Part #2) as shown. Note - Be sure that the legs are aligned at 90 degree angles before tightening the fourth leg completely.



STEP 8 - Turn the table over on a flat surface.
